



SISTER LUCIE NORDMANN SCHOLARSHIP

The Sister Lucie Nordmann Scholarship is available annually to one new or returning student attending Villa Duchesne and Oak Hill School in JK3-Grade 12. Recipients must be strong academically, demonstrated when age appropriate by grade reports, standardized test scores, and positive teacher comments. Recipients and their families must have a desire for and an openness to learning and furthering personal growth and demonstrate an active participation in their faith. While recipients are not required to be Catholic, they must show evidence of strong religious beliefs. The award will be reviewed annually providing recipients maintain their eligibility. Applicants with demonstrated financial need will be given preference. This scholarship is funded by the Sister Lucie Nordmann Scholarship Fund.

To apply for the Sister Lucie Nordmann Scholarship, the following are required:

- Completed scholarship application
- Completed SMART TUITION AID online application (*view www.vdoh.org*)
- Completed admissions application (*view brochure or www.vdoh.org; new students only*)
- Student classroom visit and parent meeting (*contact Admissions Office to schedule*)
- Transcript and standardized test scores (*requested by Admissions Office*)
- Admissions screening/testing(*contact Admissions Office to schedule; new students only*)
